

Logan House Family Recovery Units



When parents have concerns with drugs or alcohol, it can be tough to find support.

At Logan House Family Recovery Units, parents are welcome to come and stay with their young children and participate in a residential treatment program within a quiet, rural setting.

Our specialist team includes drug and alcohol and family counsellors, a treatment facilitator, a registered nurse and other allied health professionals.

We will work with you to reduce the harms associated with alcohol and drug use and help support positive change for you and your family.

The program will provide

- ▶ specialist support to help take the stress out of entering and leaving the program
- ▶ alcohol and drug counselling, using the latest research in recovery treatment
- ▶ a safe, drug, alcohol and smoking-free environment, with nicotine replacement therapy offered
- ▶ parenting and relationship support
- ▶ a focus on health and wellness including support around food and nutrition
- ▶ appropriate supervised care for children.

About us

The family recovery units are on the same site as Logan House, a long-standing alcohol and drug rehabilitation centre, which provides support to the family program.

The program is run by Lives Lived Well, a not-for-profit support organisation that provides support to people with drug or alcohol or mental health concerns across Queensland and regional NSW.

How much does it cost

We aim to provide accessible and affordable residential treatment. You will need to pay some money towards your stay, usually a portion of your Centrelink payment (if applicable). The amount will depend on the type of benefit/payment you receive.
