



FACT SHEET – Logan House Family Recovery Units

Our program, commencing January 7, 2019

We provide a unique opportunity for families to access residential alcohol and drug treatment together. Children will be provided appropriate care while parents participate in an evidence-based, structured program of support, which is tailored to individual needs. Parents will also be connected with other allied health and support services to ensure they receive holistic, wrap-around support.

Who can stay

One-parent or two-parent families can stay, with up to two children, under the age of 10. Families with three children can be accommodated on a needs' basis.

Length of stay

Most families will stay for three months. The program is designed to be delivered over six-week cycles, allowing for flexible and responsive treatment.

Environment

A peaceful place of recovery surrounded by gum trees on a rural property in Chambers Flat, just 35 minutes south of Brisbane. The property features comfortable self-contained, private units with breezy open spaces and decks from which to enjoy farmland views. The units provide for a safe, calm and secure environment.

Approach

We are passionate about working with people and take a harm minimisation approach to our treatment. We have a drug-free and non-smoking policy in place, as such our support includes nicotine replacement therapy to help people quit smoking.

Support

We offer case management across all life domains, as well as specialist alcohol and drug support. A strong focus is on providing skills around parenting, cooking, wellness, self-care and life management. This support is provided through dedicated parenting, counselling and nutrition programs.

Team

Our specialist team includes an alcohol and drug senior practitioner, two treatment facilitators and specialist support workers. The service will be supported 24/7 with an overnight support worker available.

Cost

Program cost depends on the type of benefit or payment received from Centrelink. Usually, the cost amounts to 85 per cent of a Centrelink benefit.
