

Consulting GP role

Rockhampton Recovery Centre

Lives Lived Well is excited to invite General Practitioners in Rockhampton and surrounds to be part of the new alcohol and drug residential service opening in Rockhampton in late 2021. Once operational, we will require consulting GPs to attend regularly on site, one or two days per week, at times to be negotiated, to provide the following:

- bulk-billed general medical care
- health checks and assessments
- prescription management (withdrawal support)
- GP mental health plans

This is a rare and exciting opportunity for an experienced GP, with a passion for alcohol and other drugs support to come and work alongside the Lives Lived Well team within a State Government, purpose-built centre of recovery. The centre is currently being constructed by the Queensland Government at 607-701 Yaamba Road, Parkhurst (near the Music Bowl).

The consulting GP will have:

- use of a fitted-out consulting room, free of charge
- support by a dedicated Practice Manager and Registered Nurse
- mentoring from Lives Lived Well's Addiction Medicine Specialist, Graeme Judson
- support to become an Opioid Substitution Therapy (OST) prescriber

The Lives Lived Well team is funded to deliver:

- residential rehabilitation – 32 beds (adult single rooms)
- residential withdrawal treatment unit (8 beds for adults)
- family residential rehabilitation (two 3 bedroom family units)
