

TRAINING AND SUPPORTED EMPLOYMENT PATHWAYS

Nurture is our sustainable farming and distribution cooperative at Chambers Flat, Logan. Through Nurture we offer people access to FREE hands-on, certificate-level training to receive a recognised qualification in horticulture.

The next round of training for a **Certificate II in Horticulture** starts on **27 July 2021**. The course will run three days per week over 14 weeks.

## Head down a new path

Acquire the skills and knowledge to work in the horticulture industry. Learn about:

- オ plant care
- landscape management
- plant propagation
- pruning and fertilising to maintain lawns
- operating horticultural machinery
- nursery operations.

On completion, you will receive support to help find work in the horticultural industry. We can also connect you to other support services.

Training takes place at our Logan House site in Chambers Flat, south of Brisbane.

## Who is eligible?

Nurture is open to people 15 years and over, who have completed or will soon complete treatment with Lives Lived Well. The training is also open to people with a lived experience of mental health and drug and alcohol problems.

Our partner, DGT Employment and Training, assesses each person's suitability for the program on a case-by-case basis.

## Who runs it?

Nurture is a social enterprise project funded by Lives Lived Well and the Department of Education, Small Business and Training. Its delivery is made possible thanks to the support of our partners DGT Employment and Training, Nature Cycle and Food Connect.
